Patient Consultation & Catheter Placement

Patients are scheduled and seen by their surgeon for ASEPT® catheter insertion either Pleural (M7001-CAN) or Peritoneal (M7008-CAN). Patients equipped with an IPC catheter require ongoing drainage as directed by their healthcare provider.

PFM Universal Valve Replacement

Many patients have IPC catheters with brand-specific valves that are only compatible with certain bottles. This creates challenges during urgent or emergency drainage situations.


PFM offers a universal Luer-Lok valve that can be replaced bedside, allowing compatibility with any Luer-Lok connection (including wall suction), and most importantly, enabling use with PFM drainage bottles for immediate relief.

Clinical Drainage - Jet-Vac

Following insertion, patients may require periodic drainage in clinic. PFM Jet-Vac vacuum bottles are available in 600 mL, 1000 mL, and 1500 mL volumes. Options include attached drain lines, valve-only configurations, and sampling ports for patients requiring additional testing.
